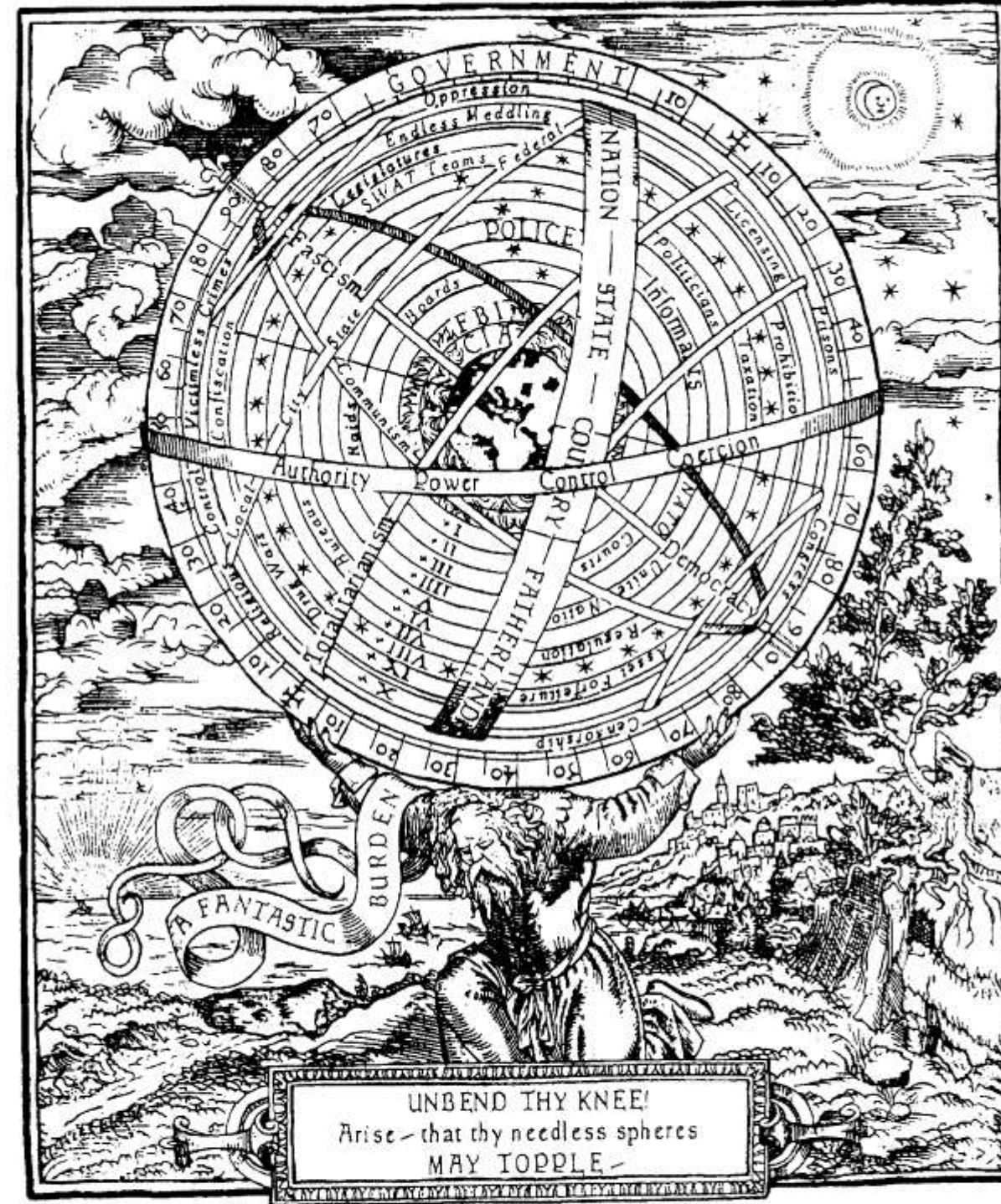
Well, John the Baptist after torturing a thief
